**Dr. Douglas Miller is an award-winning researcher and educator.**

As a neuropathologist, Miller is concerned with diseases of the nervous system. The main focus of his research deals with various aspects of central nervous system tumors, both in humans of all ages and in animals. He has also examined Alzheimer's disease in animals. Additionally, he has studied the effects of blunt head trauma, particularly in children. His work has been supported by the National Institutes of Health and other leading agencies.

Miller has written three books and numerous articles which have appeared in scientific publications including *Cancer* and the *Journal of Neurosurgery*. His works have been cited more than 11,000 times.

Over the course of his career, Miller has been recognized with numerous honors. These include a Meritorious Service Award from the New York Association of Neuropathologists and the MU School of Medicine's Outstanding Teacher Award. He is a member of the American Association of Neuropathologists and is a fellow of the College of American Pathologists.

Dr. Douglas Miller is a clinical professor of pathology and anatomical sciences and director of the Pathology Residency Program in the School of Medicine.
