Dean Steve Zweig has a focus on patient care.

Zweig's research interests include health service for older adults, advance care planning and end-of-life care. He has published numerous articles in peer-reviewed journals related to these topics. Having been in practice for 35 years, Zweig is board certified in family medicine and geriatrics as well as palliative medicine: specialized care that focuses on improving quality of life for patients and their families.

In addition to his research and practice, Zweig has a long history of service. He previously served as chair of the Missouri End-of-Life Coalition and served on the National Advisory Council for Community/State Partnerships to Improve End of Life Care. He was also associate editor of *Archives of Family Medicine*.

Zweig has been a board member and chair of the Association of Departments of Family Medicine (ADFM) Leadership Development Committee and a convener of the MU/ADFM New Chairs Workshop held each year in Columbia. He was also director of the MU Interdisciplinary Center on Aging for many years. In 2019, he was named interim dean of medicine — an appointment that university leaders enthusiastically made permanent in 2020.
